For students or those new to practicing forecasting and planning you can earn a CPF-C (Certified Professional Forecasting | Candidate) by passing the exams. Then, once you complete 1 year of professional experience IBF will upgrade you to a full CPF status.

Exam fee

The Exam fee of US \$1 125.00 for members or US \$1 275.00 for non-members will be charged in South African Rand and VAT of 15% will be added.

This fee is for 3 x 2 hour exam modules with 15 minute breaks in between. In order to pass you need to get 70% or higher for each exam.

- Exam 1: 150 multiple choice questions
- Exam 2: 125 multiple choice questions
- Exam 3: 100 multiple choice questions

Please note that should you opt to sit the exams they should be written within 6 months from the date of the payment made in respect of the exam fees.

The exams can be taken separately i.e. not in one sitting. However, there is a one-time charge of US \$100 in order to take the exams separately.

Exams are administered every second and fourth Friday of each month excluding US holidays. Exam registrations can be handled through the SAPICS office.

The cost to retake an exam is US \$375 per exam for members or US \$425 per exam for non-members. The retake fee can be paid to SAPICS.

Textbook:

The cost per textbook is R2 400.00 Excl. VAT and the cost to ship within South Africa is an additional R200 Excl. VAT. The cost to ship outside South Africa will be calculated on request. The textbook can be ordered directly from SAPICS.

Upon successful completion of the exams participants receive a certificate and may place "CPF" in their professional title.
