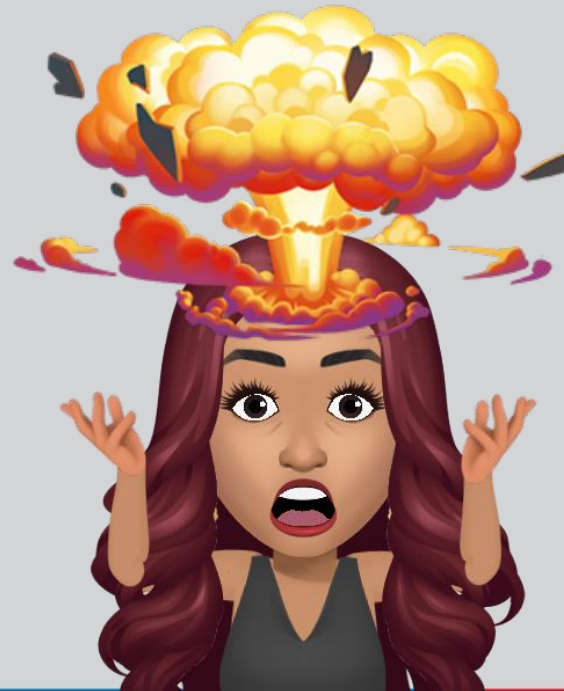

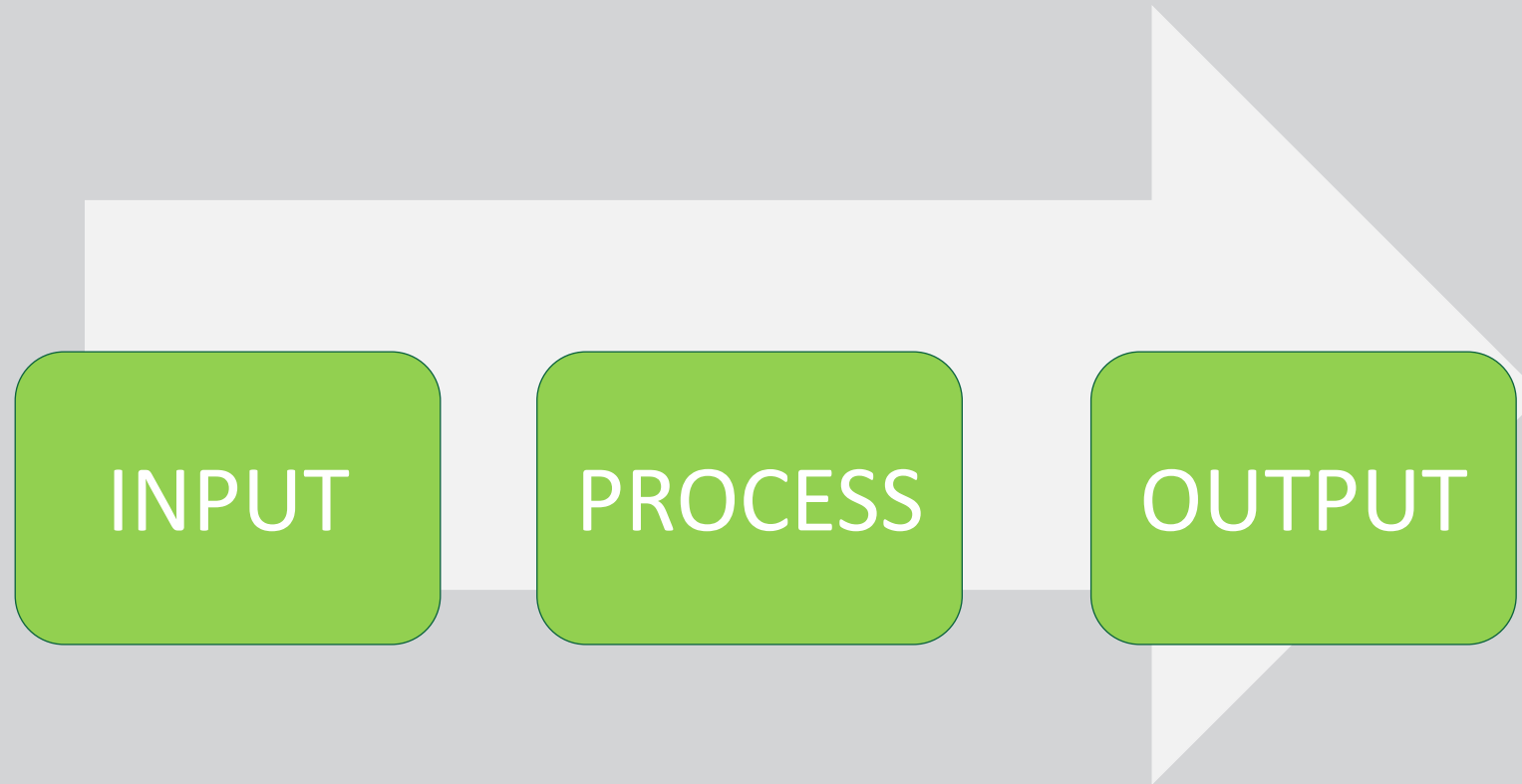

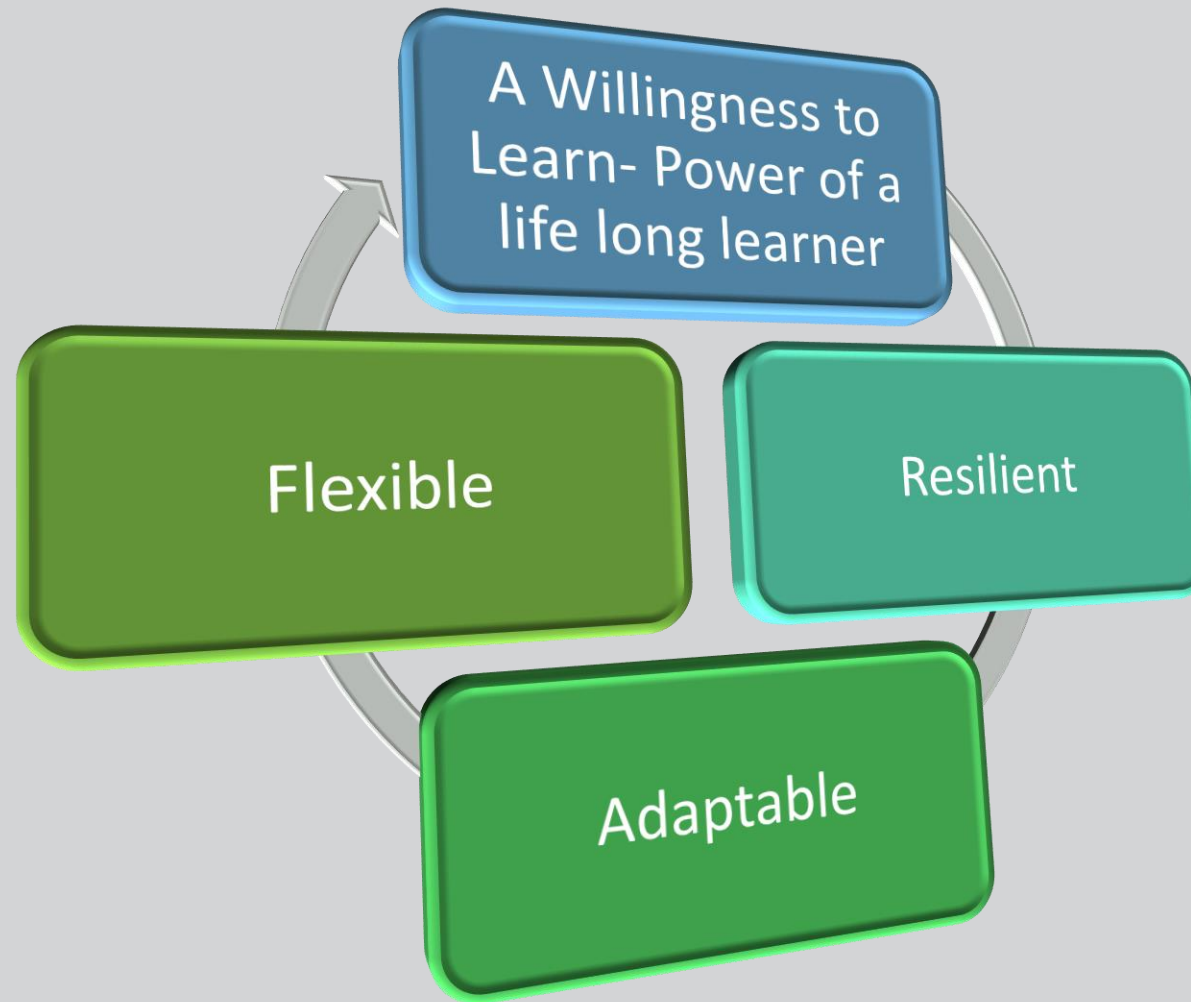

The Transformation Process



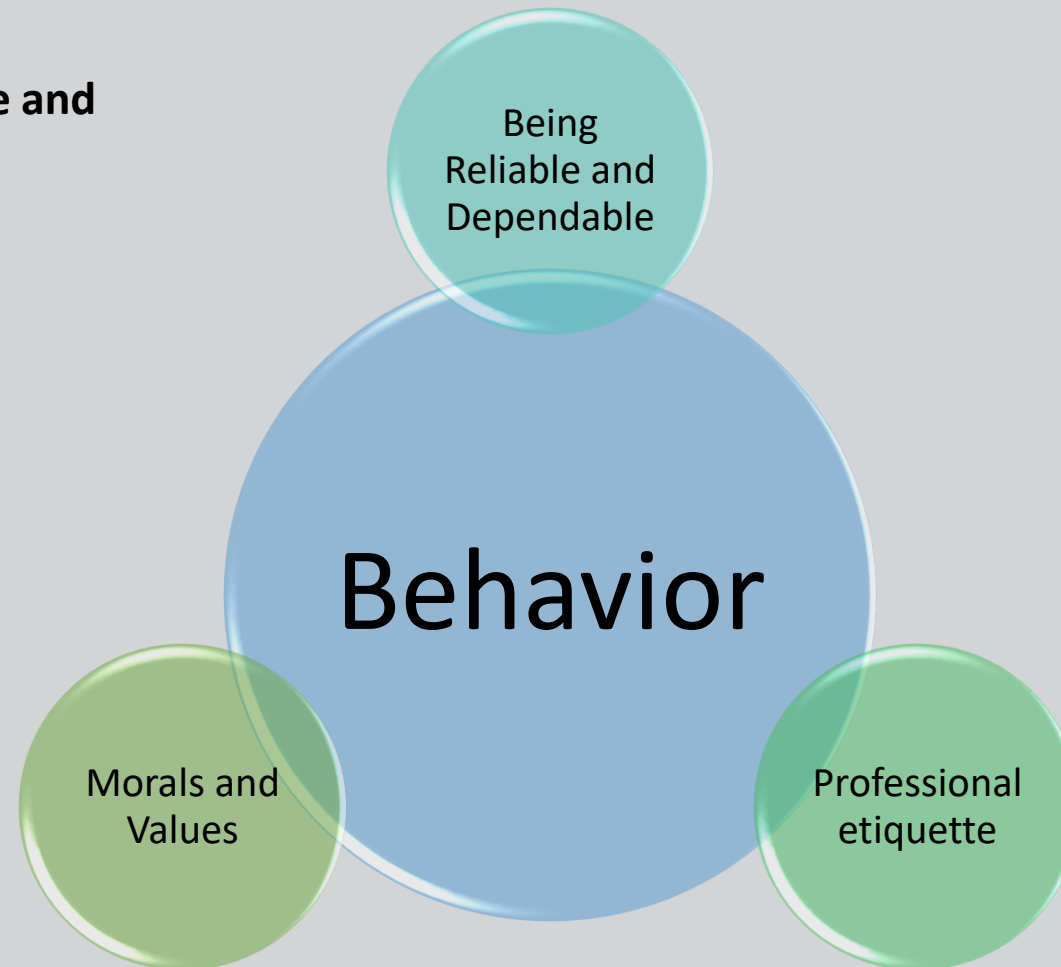
A –ATTITUDE /ATTRIBUTES

- Avoid the negative side of office politics

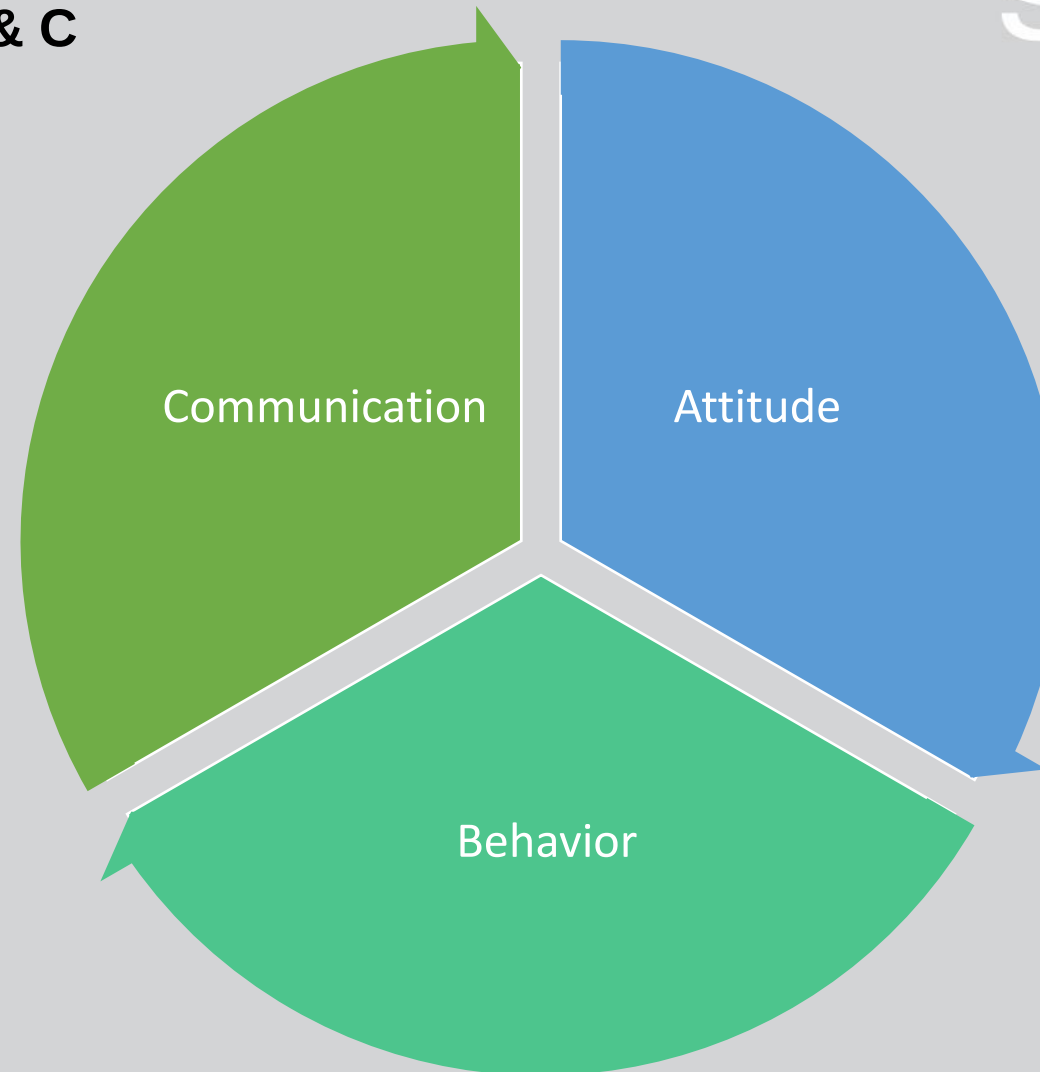
